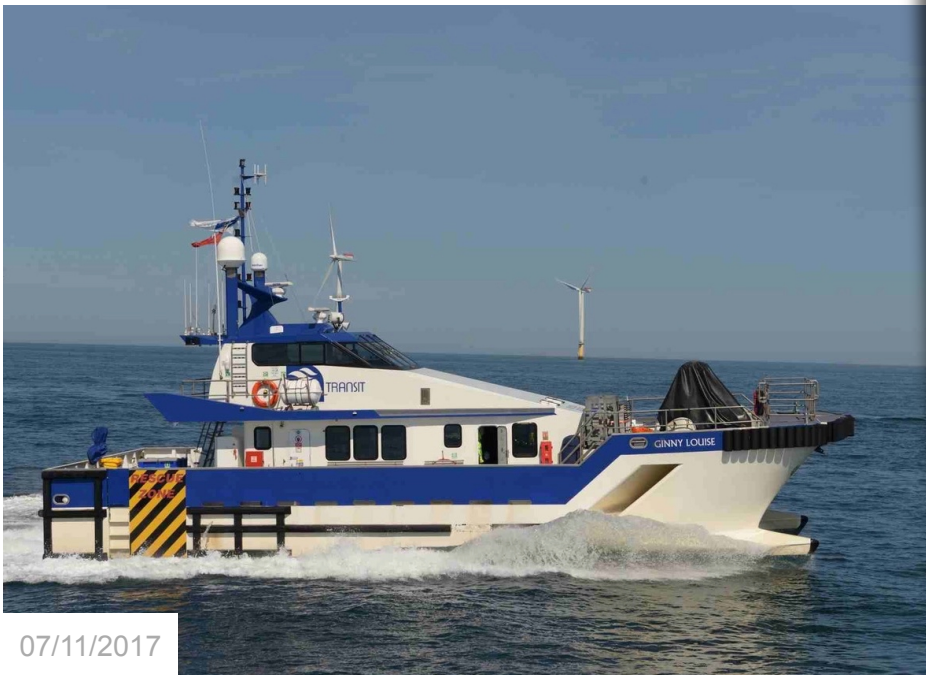

Tidal Transit widens offshore vision

Ginny Louise CTV aids monopile inspections at Lynn and Inner Dowsing project



Tidal Transit chartered its Ginny Louise crew transfer vessel to Reach Engineering and Diving Services (Reds) to carry out internal inspections of 20 monopile foundations at the 194.4MW Lynn and Inner Dowsing offshore wind farm off the UK east coast.

Reds was contracted by management company XCECO to carry out the inspections, which took 28 days to complete.
